Waste Management Policy

- 1. Systematically engage with the 3 'Rs' of environment friendliness (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle).
- 2. Use separate waste bins to collect degradable and non-degradable wastes.
- 3. Encourage the habit of reusing and recycling non-biodegradable products.
- 4. Collect paper waste produced on campus and collaborate with scrap dealers for recycling.
- 5. Reduce solid waste by developing a technology-centric teaching and administrative model
- 6. Reduce the use of paper by supporting digitization of attendance and internal assessment records.
- 7. Reduce requirement of printed books by updating the e-books and e-journals collection of the college library.
- 8. Encourage the students and teachers to submit assignments electronically.
- 9. Take initiatives to spread awareness amongst students about food wastage and ways of minimizing it and also minimizing the use of packaged food.
- 10. Organize workshops for students to create awareness and to manage various kinds of wastes.
- 11. Collaborate with e-waste recycling companies to get electronic waste recycled.
- 12. Collect chemical wastes in separate containers.
- 13. Ensure the proper functioning of the drainage system in the college.
