



SC/ ST Cell Policy

The functions of the SC/ST Cell shall include the following:

1. Ensure the implementation of the reservation policy for members belonging to SC/ ST communities.
2. Implement various policies and programmes launched by the Central Government, MHRD, UGC and State Government for the benefit of the members of the SC/ST communities.
3. Analyse information on admissions, education, training and employment of SCs and STs, and prepare reports and digests for onward transmission to the Ministry of Human Resource Development/University Grants Commission and such other authorities as may be required.
4. Deal with representations received from members of SC/ ST communities regarding admission, recruitment, promotion and other similar matters in the College.
5. Ensure prevention of atrocities against members of the SC/ST communities in the college.
6. Monitor the working of the remedial coaching for students belonging to SC/ ST communities.
7. Function as a Grievances Redressal Cell for the grievances of members belonging to SC/ST communities and render them necessary help in solving their academic as well as administrative problems.
8. Any other work assigned from time to time to promote higher education among the two communities.

These policies shall be reviewed regularly to ensure its relevance and effectiveness. Any proposed changes to the policies will be subject to approval from the relevant authorities.
