

Green Campus, Energy and Environment Policy

- 1. Protect and conserve ecological systems and resources within the campus.
- 2. Ensure judicious use of environmental resources to meet the needs and aspirations of the present and future generations.
- 3. Work with all stakeholders and the local community to raise awareness and seek the adoption of environmental good practice and the reduction of any adverse effects on the environment.
- 4. Continuously improve our contribution to climate protection and adaptation to climate change and to the conservation of global resources.
- 5. Encourage all the departments and student societies like Bhoomithrasena, NSS, NCC and others to organize events, competitions and training sessions that will bring about positive environmental changes.
- 6. Improve the efficient use of all resources, including energy and water, and reduce its consumption.
- 7. Avoid the use of disposables and flex banners and adhere to the green protocol promoted by the government of Kerala.
- 8. Conduct green audit, environment audit and energy audit.
- 9. Generate mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular cleanliness drives.
- 10. Foster to work in line with the Central government project 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'.
- 11. Encourage our students and staff to use public transportation and car-pooling.
- 12. Maintain the symbiotic relation of the institution with nature by organizing annual tree plantation drives.
- 13. Encourage landscaping initiatives to manage runoff, help recharge groundwater etc.

These policies shall be reviewed regularly to ensure its relevance and effectiveness. Any proposed changes to the policies will be subject to approval from the relevant authorities.
