



Research Policy

The Research Policy of the college aims to develop and promote scientific temper and research aptitude among all learners. The policy guidelines are:

1. A Research Committee shall be constituted under the supervision of the Principal of the College to encourage research ambience, create and sustain a research culture, and motivate faculty and students to engage in research activities.
2. An environment shall be created within the college to foster a research culture as well as provide required support through research framework and guidelines.
3. Faculty members shall be encouraged to publish research papers and undertake various research projects of social and academic importance.
4. The College shall publish a research journal to provide a platform to the faculty and researchers in the college as well as those from other academic institutions.
5. Seminars, conferences and workshops shall be on recent trends in various research topics to foster the research aptitude.
6. An innovative ecosystem shall be created and awareness about patents and Intellectual Property Rights shall be provided.
7. Community-oriented research initiatives shall be encouraged and the research findings shall be used for the social and economic development of Wayanad District.
8. Faculty and students shall be encouraged to present research papers in national and International seminars and conferences.
9. Facilitate the Introduction of more Post Graduate programmes and establishment of more research centres shall be facilitated at the college.
10. financial and infrastructural support to faculty and research scholars shall be extended to actively involved in research activities.
11. The Research Committee shall constantly monitor the research activities of the college to ensure quality and ethics in research.
12. Faculty members and the students shall conduct research in a responsible manner and avoid malpractices like plagiarism.
13. The College shall facilitate effective functioning of research collaborations with



other institutions and industries through MoUs and linkages.
